## DAY 1 LJUBLJANA, SLOVENIA

#### Our tour starts in Ljubljana with a transfer from the airport and hotel check-in.

After check-in and a brief relaxation, we will meet the guide for a walking tour of the medieval city of Ljubljana. The Slovenian capital city is Europe's best kept secret. With its rich history and culture that dates back to the 12<sup>th</sup> century, it is a feast for any a traveller. Our guide will point out all of the memorable sights: the three 100-year old bridges, Robba Fountain, Preseren Square and Ljubljana Castle. We finish our walk with a dinner and folk entertainment at a local restaurant.

#### DAY 2 LJUBLJANA – LAKE BLED – BOHINJ – LJUBLJANA

After breakfast, we embark on a full-day tour of Lake Bled, located 55 km outside of the city. With its emerald - green lake, picture - postcard church on an islet, a castle clinging to a rocky cliff and some of the highest peaks of the Julian Alps as a backdrop, Bled is truly a piece of heaven on earth. We will enjoy a relaxing boat ride in a traditional "Pletna" rowing boat to the islet to visit St. Mary's Church, where we can ring the church bell for good luck.

After lunch at a local restaurant, we return to Ljubljana and enjoy an evening at leisure.

#### DAY 3 LJUBLJANA – POSTOJNA CAVES – OPATIJA

We check out of the hotel after breakfast, and transfer to Opatija. But before we get there, we will stop for a tour of Postojna Caves followed by lunch. To best experience this spectacular dwelling of caves, we will take an unforgettable ride on an underground train and marvel at the fascinating subterranean paradise.

After a stop for lunch at a local restaurant, we will continue to Opatija where we will check in at our hotel. Enjoy a free evening in this beautiful and quiet seaside town.

#### DAY 4 OPATIJA – ROVINJ – MOTOVUN – OPATIJA

Our tour of the Istria region takes us to Rovinj, a charming, picturesque town situated on the western Istrian coast. The Upper Town is situated on the Monte Rosso hill and is the most attractive part of the town which is filled with narrow, shady streets and secret passages, numerous traditional restaurants, art galleries and arts and crafts shops. After our guided walking tour, we will enjoy free time for lunch on our own.

We will then visit Motovun, a hilltop town with a magnificent view of the surrounding hills and river valleys. Take a walk along the Town Walls which date back to the 11th and 12th centuries when the tall and mighty bulwarks were built.

By mid-afternoon, we will make our way back to to Opatija.

#### DAY 5 OPATIJA – PLITVICE LAKES – SIBENIK

After breakfast we will check-out and depart for a our of Plitvice Lakes, which according to many is the most beautiful national park in Europe and a must-see attraction. This UNESCO World Heritage site boasts 16 small cascading lakes joined by waterfalls created by the sedimentation of travertine. We will enjoy breathtaking views as we walk the trails around the Lower Lakes area. After free time for lunch, we continue to Sibenik and embark our yacht. After we settle in, we will enjoy a Welcome Dinner onboard. We overnight in Sibenik.

#### DAY 6 SIBENIK - SPLIT

This morning we will enjoy a walking tour of the fortified town of Sibenik, founded by the Croats. The city was first mentioned in documents in the 11th century at the time of progress of the medieval Croatian state. Sibenik was also under the Venetian rule for 400 years, and from that period remains the most significant historical and cultural site of Sibenik – the Cathedral of St. Jacob. After our guided tour of Sibenik, we will have free time to explore the town before we return to our yacht for lunch as we set sail for Split.

The largest town in Dalmatia and the second-largest in all of Croatia, Split is a quintessential Mediterranean city, with a small-town vibe, vibrant streets, and easy-going locals. Located within emperor Diocletian's Palace, Split's historic old town dates back to the Roman times. It is literally an open-air living museum. On our guided walking tour of this UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site, we will see the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's Temple, the Peristyle and much more. And in the evening, we will explore the town on our own, and find our favourite restaurant for dinner.

#### DAY 7 SPLIT - BOL / BRACH ISLAND - HVAR

In the morning, we sail from Split to Bol, a little tourist town said to have the most attractive beach in Croatia called "The Golden Horn". It is a vast, golden pebble beach some 530 meters long, quite unique as it changes shape and position depending on the winds. After leisure time in Bol, we will continue sailing to the island of Hvar. The town of Hvar gained glory and power during the Middle Ages while being an important port within the Venetian naval empire. Thus Hvar Town has preserved an intricately carved Venetian architecture. Admire the views from the hilltop Spanjol Fortress, where you will look out over the red-tile-roofed town below. On our walking tour, we will pass by the first public theatre in Europe and have an evening free to explore the town on our own and dine at one of the many local restaurants.

#### DAY 8 HVAR ISLAND – VIS ISLAND

After breakfast, we will depart for Vis Island, the furthest Croatian island from the mainland. Vis island has a complicated, multicultural history, having been ruled by the Ancient Greeks, Romans, Venetians, Austrians, and Italians. Vis Town has Venetian-style architecture with roads of the characteristic white limestone from nearby Brač Island. We will explore this breathtaking gem of island with beautiful beaches, hidden coves, a fascinating history, and a rich cultural heritage.

#### DAY 9 VIS - BISEVO ISLAND - KORCULA ISLAND

After breakfast we will depart for Bisevo Island and we will visit the beautiful Blue Caves. Korcula, the acclaimed birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. The Old Town is a cluster of remarkable Venetian-gothic architecture on a narrow peninsula. Lustrous Korcula stone formed the basis for a highly refined stone-carving tradition evident in the balustrades and reliefs of Korcula town. Join our walking tour that will take you through narrow, cobbled streets and will include visit to the majestic Gothic-Baroque Cathedral of St. Mark.

#### DAY 10 KORCULA - MLJET

This morning we will sail to the island of Mljet where we will visit Mljet National Park. The park includes two deep bays which, due to their extremely narrow links with the sea, are regarded as the Great Lake and the Small Lake. Mljet is also very rich in cultural heritage, the most prominent example being the complex of the 12th century Benedictine monastery, located on a small island in the middle of The Great Lake.

#### DAY 11 MLJET ISLAND – DUBROVNIK

We will take a magnificent trip along the shores of Elaphiti archipelago consisting of fifteen islands stretched northwest of Dubrovnik. On route to Dubrovnik, we will stop for oyster tasting in the village of Ston, and in the afternoon hours we will reach Dubrovnik, rightfully named "The Pearl of the Adriatic". We will enjoy a guided walking tour of the Old town that everyone comes to see when visiting this jewel city; its buildings with narrow alleyways, redbricked roofs and a smattering of churches all encased by high city walls. Overnight in Gruz port, Dubrovnik.

#### DAY 12 DUBROVNIK - DISEMBARKATION - KOTOR - DUBROVNIK

Today our beautiful Adriatic Adventure ends, and we say goodbye to our friendly crew and staff onboard MS ANTARIS. Our group will disembark and continue with a coach tour to Kotor, Montenegro. Kotor is a UNESCO World Heritage Site located on a scenic bay on the Adriatic coast. Built between the 12th and 14th century, it displays beautifully preserved medieval architecture and historic monuments. We will meet our local guide for a walking tour of the old historic town and we'll sail to the man-made islet of Our Lady of the Rocks, topped by a lone church and steeped in legends. Back on shore, we will enjoy lunch and return to Dubrovnik in the early evening where we will check-in at our hotel. Free evening in Dubrovnik.

#### DAY 13 DUBROVNIK

Today we will explore the beautiful old town on our own, and we will meet our group again in the early evening for a Farewell Dinner in the Konavle Valley just outside of Dubrovnik.

Built for the 2019 season, the 54m long luxury vessel has the latest state-of-the-art equipment and amenities. The maximum capacity of 38 passengers, in 19 twin or double cabins, guarantees an intimate setting for all guests.


